



REGULATIONS

- Access to the campsite is **authorized** by Management further to registering your identification details as required by law. Inside the structure guests and visitors must wear the **recognition bracelet** in a visible way, for the whole period of stay, the same, together with the car pass must be given back on departure and, in any case, when not staying overnight inside the structure;
- Minors, even if they have an identification document, can be hosted only if they are accompanied by their parents or by persons of legal age with the appropriate consent issued by them;
- The daily amount of the stay is calculated on the basis of the daily rates from the moment of arrival until 9 a.m. the following day, after which an additional day will be charged;
- Check-in for the accommodation starts at 10:00 a.m., delivery of the keys will take place by 4:00 p.m., check-out by 9:00 a.m., after this time it is not possible to stay inside or use the services of the structure;
- Occupying the bays and parking spaces is subject to approval from the management;
- From **14:00 till 16:00** and from **24:00 till 08:00** silence is prescribed. In respect of peace and quiet it is forbidden to carry out any activity that may cause disturbance, so you cannot circulate inside the campsite by any means, washing dishes or linen. In addition, the volume of radios, TVs and similar devices must be limited. From **9.00 p.m. to 8.00 a.m.** the use of bicycles, skates, scooters, skateboards etc. is also forbidden;
- **Visitors** must report to the Management. Their stay for the **first hour is free**, after which the daily rate must be paid;
- **Cars** may only be driven into the parking area/residential unit upon arrival or before departure, for the unloading/loading of luggage and equipment, after which they must only enter the **parking area** and be parked in the assigned spaces;
- Visitors are **not allowed** into the campsite on the 15th August;
- Campers are responsible for all their property and **Management does not accept any liability** for theft or damage, apart from any items delivered to them and accepted in safekeeping;
- Vehicles must not exceed **10 km/hour** when travelling around the campsite areas;
- Do not pour boiling water or detergents onto the plants, and generally all the vegetation, cleanliness and correct use of campsite equipment must be respected;
- Children must be constantly cared for and accompanied by a responsible adult when travelling and using the campsite's equipment. The Management declines all responsibility for accidents;
- Guests are required to follow **the sorted waste collection procedure**, which must be delivered to the ecological oasis located inside the campsite, in accordance with the procedures and time slots indicated therein;
- Anyone found committing acts of vandalism to the structures and equipment in the campsite areas **will immediately be expelled**;

- It is strictly forbidden to light and leave **open flames** unattended, as well as the use of the barbecue on the pitch, in the accommodation and, in any case, outside the spaces dedicated to them;
- **Animals are allowed** to enter only if expressly authorized by the **Management** after showing the relative health booklet, updated with the prescribed vaccinations and the insurance certificate for civil liability. The owner must keep the dog on a leash, equipped with a special muzzle, accompany it outside the campsite for daily needs, be in possession of a special kit for collecting manure, intervene promptly if they occur inside the campsite, using suitable finally, sanitizers and worry about not disturbing other guests;
- The 4-legged friends can freely access the beach dedicated to them and stay under the umbrella, always respecting the rules indicated in the previous point, in the same way they can access the restaurant, following the path indicated by the Management, avoiding to pass in the area forbidden to them;
- It's not possible to attach any type of sheet on the trees or assemble any structure upon the bay; moreover, any carpet/floor must strictly be of breathable material such as shade cloth and not linoleum and must not exceed the outline of the assembled equipment;
- At the discretion of Management, anyone who fails to respect these regulations or behaves in a manner that is contrary to civil living, could be **immediately expelled** from the campsite as an undesirable guest;
- These regulations are posted at the entrance and form an integral part of the booking contract. The act of entry into the structure is the tacit acceptance by the Guests.
