



## CAMPSITE RULES

- **Access to the campsite** must be authorized by the Management upon registration of personal identification details, as required by law. **Guests and visitors must wear the provided wristband** visibly at all times during their stay. The wristband, together with the car pass, must be returned upon departure or whenever guests do not stay overnight inside the campsite.
- **Children under 18**, even if in possession of an ID document, may only stay if accompanied by their parents or by adults holding written authorization from the parents.
- The daily rate is calculated from the time of arrival until 9:00 a.m. of the following day. After this time, an additional day will be charged.
- **Check-in** for accommodation units starts at 10:00 a.m.; units will be available by 4:00 p.m. **Check-out** must take place by 9:00 a.m. After this time, it is not permitted to remain inside the campsite or use the campsite facilities.
- Occupation of a pitch and/or **parking** space is subject to Management approval.
- **Quiet hours** are from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and from 12:00 midnight to 8:00 a.m. During these hours, any activity that may disturb other guests is prohibited. It is therefore not allowed to circulate inside the campsite with any vehicle or to wash dishes or laundry. The volume of radios, TVs and similar devices must be kept low at all times. From 9:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m., the use of bicycles, roller skates, scooters, skateboards, etc. is also prohibited.
- **Visitors** must report to the Management upon arrival. The first hour is free of charge; thereafter, the daily rate must be paid.
- **Cars** may enter the pitch/accommodation only upon arrival or prior to departure for loading and unloading luggage and equipment. Afterwards, vehicles must be parked exclusively in the designated parking areas.
- **On August 15th, visitors are not allowed** inside the campsite.
- **Campers are responsible for their personal belongings.** The Management declines all responsibility for theft or damage, except for items formally entrusted and accepted for safekeeping.
- The maximum speed for vehicles in the campsite is **10 km/h.**
- It is forbidden to pour boiling water or detergents onto plants. Guests must **respect the vegetation**, cleanliness, and proper use of campsite facilities.

- **Children** must always be **supervised** and accompanied by a responsible adult when moving around or using campsite facilities. The Management declines any responsibility for accidents.
- Guests must comply with the **separate waste collection** procedures. Waste must be disposed of in the ecological area located within the campsite, following the indicated rules and time schedules.
- Anyone caught **vandalizing** facilities or equipment of the campsite will be immediately expelled.
- It is strictly **forbidden to light or leave unattended open flames**. The use of barbecues on pitches, inside accommodations, or outside designated areas is not permitted.
- **Pets are allowed** in the designated camping area only with prior authorization from the Management and upon presentation of a valid health record with required vaccinations and proof of liability insurance. Dogs must be kept on a leash and equipped with a muzzle if required. Owners must take their dogs outside the campsite for daily needs, carry appropriate waste disposal kits, promptly clean up any mess within the campsite using suitable sanitizing products, and ensure that their pets do not disturb other guests.
- **Four-legged friends** may freely access the designated pet-friendly beach area and stay under the beach umbrella, always respecting the above rules. They may also access the restaurant by following the path indicated by the Management and avoiding restricted areas.
- **It is forbidden** to attach any type of fabric to trees or to install overhead structures on the pitch. Carpets and/or flooring must be made of breathable material (e.g., shade cloth – no plastic or linoleum) and must not exceed the outline of the installed equipment.
- At the discretion of the Management, anyone who fails to comply with these rules or behaves contrary to the principles of civil coexistence may be immediately removed as an undesirable guest.
- These regulations form an integral part of the booking contract. Entry into the campsite implies full and tacit acceptance of these rules by the Guests.
